- Working effectively with colleagues to ensure that VOHRC is effectively represented with various stakeholders' clients, partners, funders etc
- Support the development and promotion of VOHRC programs and activities
- Make referrals to other relevant community resources, programs and services
- Write funder reports, program plans and create systems to monitor program outcomes
- Develop and strengthen alliances with other community partners for the delivery of programs that respond to the needs of participants
- Lead community engagement activities and events as directed
- Other duties as required.
